IT IS ORDERED

1. The records held by the agencies served and all judicial branch records relating to the arrest, charging indictment, or trial of the petitioner shall be sealed. The existence of the records shall not be disclosed to anyone except as authorized by the court order, or statute.
2. The Court Administrator shall also, remove all computer entries for this file naming the petitioner.
3. The petitioner's name shall be removed from all index books.
4. All sealed records shall remain sealed and undisclosed unless disclosure is authorized by the court or specific statutory authority.
5. No records shall be destroyed or returned to the petitioner.
6. If the expunged conviction was for a crime of violence as defined in Minn. Stat. § 624.712, subd. 5, Petitioner is subject to all previously imposed firearm restrictions, and is not entitled to ship, transport, possess, or receive a firearm for the remainder of Petitioner's lifetime.
